SCULPTURAL PUPPETRY : combining the line and form of sculpture with the playful anima of puppetry. The bodies are built over a wire armature using polymer clay and fibre construction. This is designed to allow motion during and to some degree after the figure is created. It is an inventive process that is both delicate and strong. Her work is her muse, a silent imprint or suggested feeling created through the posture and expression of the figure evolving in front of her. These works also reflect outward involving the viewer in a conversation or connection to an experience of themselves.

An artist of delicacy and detail, Kate's work mirrors the varied experiences of her life in her offbeat quirky method of recognition. Her figures speak of curiosity, delight, tenderness and humor... expressions of some of the exquisitely charming characteristics of life.

Her works are part of the 2011 International Ceramic Exhibit in the incredible castle of Cesky Krumlov in the Czech Republic. She also has pieces showing in the Lunenburg Art Gallery in Nova Scotia.
