Diane Foster has been a sculptor specializing in miniatures for many years. She taught herself to make ceramic molds and specialized tools for her miniatures, and sold kits through wholesale distributors and through three miniature magazines. Beginning in the 1980s, Diane took numerous classes and seminars from Theo Menzenbach, former master sculptor for the Hummel factory, in her pursuit to sculpt dolls in dollhouse scale.

Diane has been a polymer clayer for numerous years and after attending a Bob Wiley workshop and after much valued support from Babette Cox, Carolyn Skei, and Nancy Lotzer, she has been hooked. She still likes sculpting, but doing it in polymer takes a whole different set of skills and she is still working at it. In her words, Diane likes to “putz”, to figure out how to do something.

Diane will demonstrate how to make the following items: Turkey with Stuffing, Stuffing on the side, Dinner Rolls, Buttered Mashed Potatoes, Green Beans, Carrots, Corn, Relish Tray of Pickles and Olives, Cranberry Sauce, Deviled Eggs, Sweet Potato Casserole, Pumpkin Pie and Cherry Pie.

In addition, Diane has made tiny ceramic dishes that will be for sale to workshop attendees.
